"We started gathering children and adults little by little in smaller groups. The groups would meet for a few hours and in these hours, we would play the RiverCross drama. We saw huge results through and through. The women being trained started spreading the program across many villages to others."

What We Do

We train people to be champions who use our audio dramas to set the world's vulnerable children free from trauma and free to thrive.

OUR TRAINING PROGRAM HAS THREE LEVELS:

Engage Groups

Through discussion groups, we use our audio dramas to raise awareness of the effects of trauma in the lives of vulnerable children resulting in increased compassion, collaborative understanding, and intentional action.

TARGET - Those who have a heart for vulnerable children

Equip Workshops

Through workshops anchored by our audio dramas, we train people in evidence-based essentials of trauma care and resiliency. They are equipped to use our audio dramas with their teams and the children they serve.

TARGET – Those who are working with vulnerable children

Empower Partnerships

Through partnerships with aligned organizations, we use our audio dramas to train trainers and coach leaders to lead workshops and activate trauma-informed strategies that empower people to set vulnerable children free to thrive.

Year-In-Review **2023 MILESTONES**

New Audio Drama

After ten years of using our flagship program, Holding Esther, the time had come for a new audio drama. We learned much from our African partners about the real issues they face, as well as how they use the program and ways we could improve it. Bridge to Freedom is the result of ten years of experience, research, and an \$87,000 investment from key stakeholders.

RiverCross Summit in Uganda and Kenya

114 leaders from 7 countries representing 32 organizations gathered for two 3-day workshops anchored by Bridge to Freedom. Six weeks after the RiverCross Summit, 92% of the participants reported that they have been able to use what they learned in their work and lives.

Bridge to Freedom in Shona

Shona is the preferred language across Zimbabwe. Through a grant from Harvard University and in partnership with the University of Zimbabwe, Bridge to Freedom was produced in Shona.

This program will anchor a RiverCross teacher training program set to impact the lives of 4,000 students in Zimbabwe government schools. Measurement and evaluation of the effectiveness of this program is being conducted by Harvard University.
